Bradley, 20th Battalion, I have to inform you official advice received here shows that he absented himself without leave at Beaupre on 14.4.17 and remained absent until arrested by the Military Police on 30.4.17. He was found guilty of this offence at a Field General Court Martial held in this connection and sentenced to 12 months imprisonment with hard labour on 9.6.17.

Sir,

I am writing to you in reference to my late Son No. 4658 Private William Bradley. 20th Battalion A.Coy 5th Brigade. who Enlisted about November 1915 and Embarked on the 12th of April 1916. My Husband has been suffering from Asthma for the past 20 Years and has been unable to follow his usual occupation for some considerable time. My Son herein mentioned was my main support prior to his enlistment and when he enlisted he left 3/- per Diem allotment in my favour.

On or about July 1917 I received Official information from the Defence department to the effect, that my Son had overdrawn Fourteen Pounds £14 and my allotment was cancelled immediately and I have not received anything from the time of cancellation. I would like to know if my Son underwent any punishment from the Military prior to his death, and if so what was the result. Also when my ~~XXXXXXXX~~ allotment shall be fixed up as I am in urgent need of the Money, also when I shall be able to receive deferred pay. I have made application to the Pay Office Victoria Barracks Paddington without receiving any satisfactory results, therefore I am taking the liberty of asking you to assist me in the matter, Trusting that you will answer me favourably at your earliest convenience.
