





State whether he leaves (b) in Small Book (if at Base)

All private documents and effects received from the front or hospital, as well as the Pay Book, should be examined, and if any will is found it should be at once forwarded to the War Office.

(c) as a separate document

Any information received as to verbal expressions by a deceased soldier of his wishes as to the disposal of his estate should be reported to the War Office as soon as possible.

A duplicate of this Report is to be sent to the Paymaster at the Base (see Field Service Regulations, Part II.), together with the deceased's Pay Book (after withdrawal of any will from the latter). If the deceased's Small Book is at the Base, it should be forwarded to the War Office with this Report.

In reply to yours of the 14th inst., I beg to state that as your son has not been reported seriously wounded further particulars are not expected unless he does not continue to make satisfactory progress towards recovery. Egypt has reported that in the absence of any further information, it is to be assumed that all wounded are maintaining this satisfactory condition. On account of the congestion in Egypt and the wide distribution of the wounded to hospitals all over the Mediterranean, the free cable concession except in serious or dangerous cases, has had to be discontinued. Any further advice coming to hand regarding your son will be immediately communicated to you.


