
LOVE PINE CEMETERY, GALLIOLI,

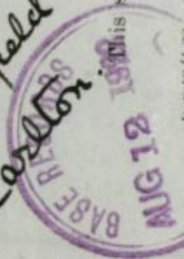

In reply to yours of the 14th inst., I beg to state that as your son has not been reported seriously wounded further particulars are not expected unless he does not continue to make satisfactory progress towards recovery. Egypt has reported that in the absence of any further information, it is to be assumed that all wounded are maintaining this satisfactory condition. On account of the congestion in Egypt and the wide distribution of the wounded to hospitals all over the Mediterranean, the free cable concession except in serious or dangerous cases, has had to be discontinued. Any further advice coming to hand regarding your son will be immediately communicated to you.

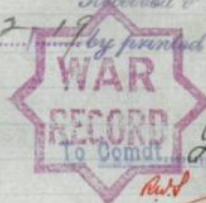
