Awarded for 3 years, 360, 180 or 90 days, depending on area and nature of service

Country  United Kingdom

Presented by the Monarch of the United Kingdom and the Dominions of the British Commonwealth, and Emperor of India

Eligibility Military and certain civilian service

Campaign(s) Second World War

Established May 1945

Awarded for 28 days of service

Presented by the Monarch of the United Kingdom and the Dominions of the British Commonwealth, and Emperor of India

Eligibility Full-time personnel of all ranks

Campaign(s) Second World War 1939-45

Established 16 August 1945

Awarded for Twelve years of efficient service

Country  United Kingdom

Presented by the Monarch of the United Kingdom and the British Dominions, and Emperor of India

Eligibility Part-time other ranks and some officers

Clasps For further periods of 6 years service

Status Still current in New Zealand
