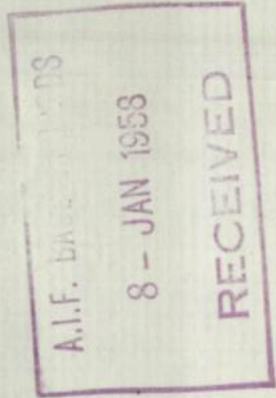

I have to acknowledge receipt of your communication of 30th April, and in reply regret to inform you that no photographs of the grave of your son, the late No. 6964 Private P.H. Condon, 13th Battalion, have been received at this office, and in the absence of official advice of registration it must be reluctantly concluded that the Graves Services have not succeeded in locating his resting place.

Failing the recovery and identification of the actual remains, it is the intention of the authorities to perpetuate the memory of these fallen by means of collective memorials on which the soldier's full regimental description and date of death will be inscribed. These monuments will be erected in certain defined battle areas in France and Belgium in commemoration of those who fell in the neighborhood, and for whom no actual graves have been identified.

There is no record at this office of any previous correspondence having been received from you in this connexion.
