I have to acknowledge receipt of your communication dated the 3rd inst., and to inform you that your brother No. 147 Private H. D. Corney, 13th Battalion, is now reported as having been admitted to the 1st Auxiliary Hospital, Abbassia, on the 14th ultimo, suffering from Jaundice and Tonsillitis. He is not reported as seriously ill, however, and in the absence of further reports favorable progress may be assumed, it being the practice of the overseas authorities to notify such cases that develop dangerously. 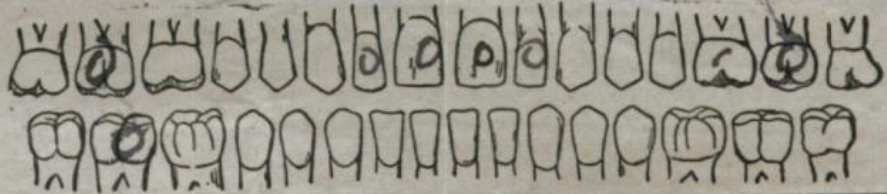

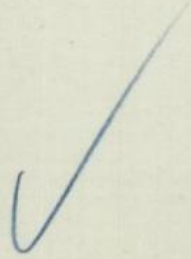

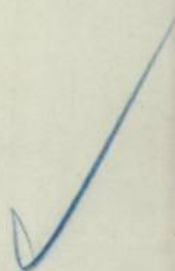
