

Dear Madam,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 6th instant, concerning your brother, No. 1747 Private W. Downey, 4th Battalion, reported missing between 6th and 9th August last, and to inform you no further information has since come to hand.

Before any investigations can be made in thematter, it will be necessary for you to obtain from the soldier referred to, a Statutory Declaration in support of his statement that your brother was killed. Upon receipt of same inquiries will be instituted, and the result communicated to you in due course.

You are also informed that when a soldier is reported missing and cannot be satisfactorily accounted for, a Court of Inquiry is held at a later date to collect all evidence of the case and record an opinion as to whether it is reasonable to suppose the soldier is dead. It is not known here whether such Court has yet been held in the case of your brother.


