



With further reference to the report of burial of your son, the late No.2869 Private A.E.Lowe, 14th M.G.Coy., I very much regret having to inform you that according to advice recently to hand from the Imperial War Graves Commission the cross erected in Plot 1 Row I, of the Anzac Cemetery, Sailly-sur-la-Lys, is of a memorial nature only, and that in the absence of proper means of identification the authorities have been unable to define with certainty the site of the late soldier's final resting place.

It is believed, however, as the result of exhaustive enquiries, that grave No.1, in the above plot and row, contains the remains of your son, and in the circumstances the Commission has decided to provisionally accept this grave as that of the late Private Lowe. A permanent headstone will accordingly be erected and engraved with the late soldier's regimental particulars and date of death, together with the personal inscription previously furnished in this connection, and as in the case of presumed burials the usual cross inscription will be preceded by the words "Believed to be" unless you express a wish for their omission, when the headstone will be completed in all respects similar to those erected over identified graves and without reference to the provisional nature of the site.

I should therefore be obliged if you would kindly favor me with your early intimation regarding the inclusion or otherwise of the words "Believed to be" as arrangements have now been made for the permanent constructional work of the Anzac Cemetery to be proceeded with.

Thanking you in anticipation, and assuring you of the Department's regret at the distressing circumstances arising.

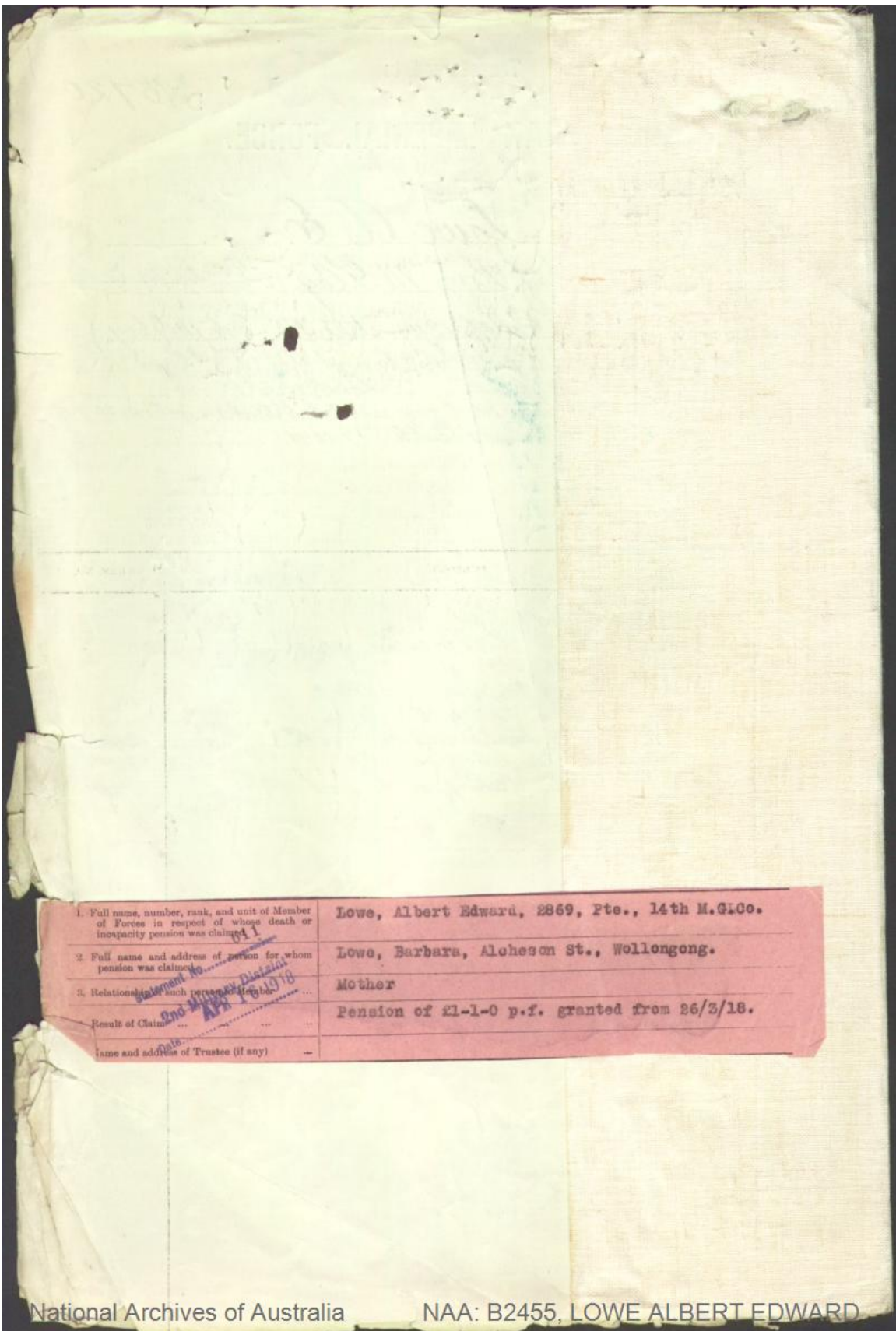
