

I am certain the Pte Ring was killed as I saw he had a bad wound in the chest. I was wounded about a quarter of an hour afterwards, and do not know what became of his body.

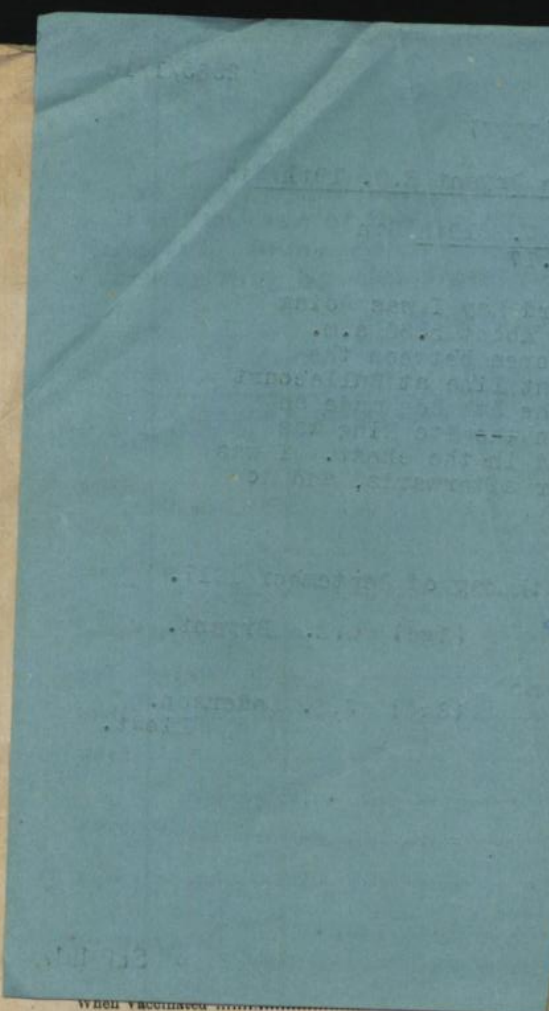
